Team Drop Off & Pick Up

Cars can start to park (free on weekends) around the Southern end of the Stadium and as these fill up, traffic control staff will direct you to overflow car parks to the North and East. BUSES must only use the designated **BUS DROP OFF ZONE** at Chancellor State College Secondary Campus – they will not be able to access the front of the stadium. The front entry is fenced off outside of these hours for trade displays and student safety. See map attached below.

Team Registrations

Team coaches need to collect team packs from Registration desk and hand in **signed media consent** forms. Coaches distribute passes to competitors and staff. **There is no access to the USC stadium for non-pass holders. Spectator tickets are available for sale on the event website.** Robots will be weighed and measured in the pits. This must be done by **8.20 am**. Priority will be given to Sumo competitors who have a tight schedule to keep to!

Pits Access

Pits will open at 7.30 am for competitors and coaches. Pits close to coaches at 8.25 am. **For the rest of the day only competitors with passes can access the pits.** There will be a Pits Marshall on all entries and exits. If a student needs to talk to their coach, they need to come out of their pits area. This is to ensure that all coding and building of robots is work done by competitors and not coaches and to decrease traffic in the pits. The sumo rotations will be projected on screens in the pits and available through a website link. Power outlets will be available in the pits. Ensure all batteries are marked with the name of your organisation.

Consent & Safety Procedures

Media Consent Forms are compulsory for this live-streamed event and are available on the competition website. Attendees need to follow signs, procedures and instructions as directed by event staff. Please observe social distancing **in large queues or groups**, especially during morning tea and lunch breaks. Hand sanitising stations must be used.

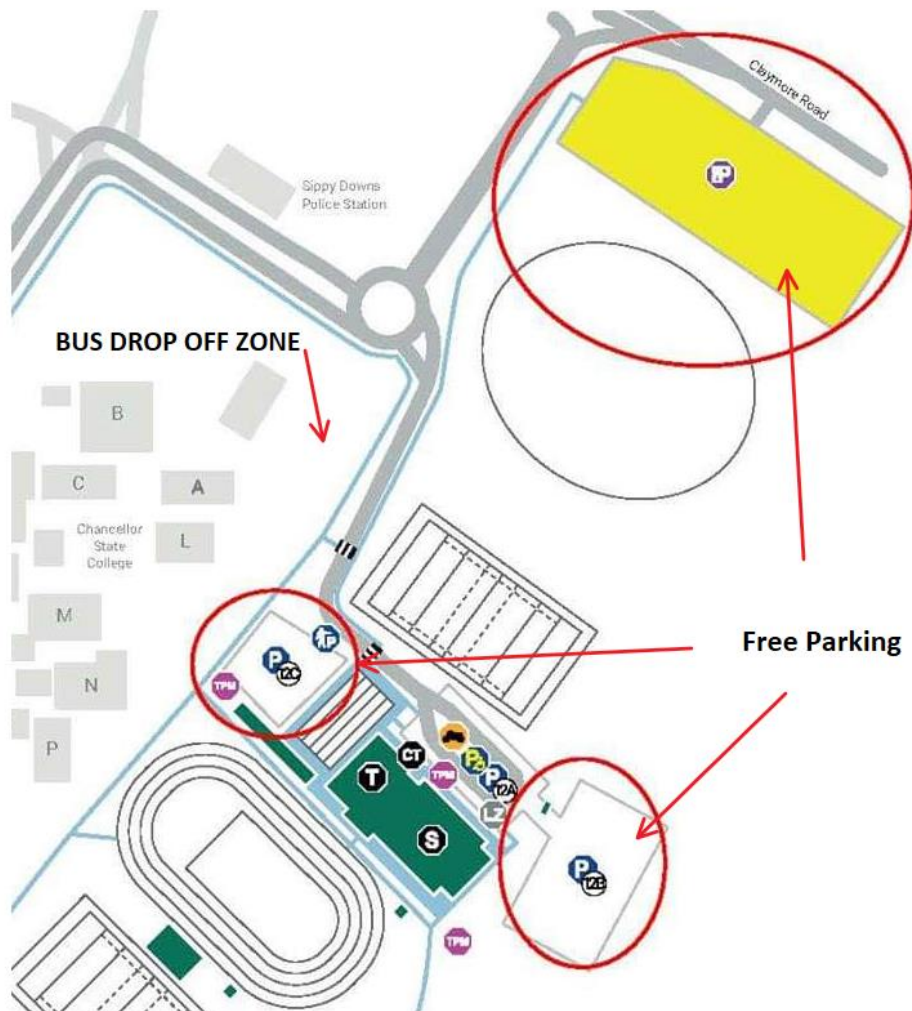
Ticketed Seating is provided in the East Stand. Staff that you have registered DO NOT HAVE TO PAY FOR A TICKET. They will have access with the lanyard that we supply in the Team Registration Bag. Groups should try to use the **same seats** for the opening & closing ceremonies. **Spectator tickets are available for sale on the event website.**

Food & Catering

The USC Sports Café will be open all day for coffees, food and refreshments. A number of food vans will be in attendance and there are fast-food outlets within walking distance. Students can eat in the Breezeway and on the grass. All **SUMO competitors** will need to strictly adhere to the **TIME SCHEDULE** so that they do not miss any rounds. Volunteers will have lunches provided. It is a good idea for coaches and parents to buy food early before competitors are release for their break times!

Trade Stands, Entertainment & all-day Parking

There will be a number of businesses displaying technology at the entrance to the event, accessible by the public. Students should be supervised by coaches in this area. Free parking is available opposite McDonalds, with limited parking behind the USC stadium.
